SUMMARY:

When one ponders the meaning of the word synthesis, you may think of the combination of certain elements, the creation of one whole from separate entities. This album—"Entremets D'Hier" is synthesis. As described, this album is the combination of separate creations from both Squarewell and Fugo. Spanning the globe from Louisville, Kentucky USA, to Aarau, Switzerland—the past (Fugo) and present creations (Squarewell) of the artists are all collected on this release to form one CD that describes musically what it means to "create." With several releases in the pockets of each artist, this synthesis of music takes released, unreleased and brand new material from each and places them together. In realistic terms, a "split CD" is not the best calling for the combination of music between these two artists. They compliment each other's uniqueness too much to do so.

BACKGROUND:

Squarewell joined together in summer of 2003 when 'My Life Denial,' a band with Drake and drummer Martin Kehl, broke up. Guitarist Matt Jagers and bassist Bryan Jones rounded out the line up soon after. After touring much of the US with several national bands and then touring Europe with locally known band La Par Force and Rusticate the band has released over five discs and is currently working on a new full-length album.
